We need access to ALL of your windows. Please make sure ALL items are removed from the window area. Please remove all items off the top of your stove and on the burners as well. Call in any work orders before the inspection at 273-4717. Poor housekeeping, missing fire detectors, and any damage beyond ordinary wear and tear are grounds for a failed inspection.

2020 CALENDARS

You should be receiving your new 2020 calendar from the Watervliet Housing Authority at the beginning of the new year. MOUSE PROBLEMS

It's getting colder and mice like to go where it's warm. Keep all garbage in tight containers. If they get into your apartment call us and we will place traps in your apartment.

EMERGENCY PHONE CALLS

Per the Tenant Handbook: "Emergencies are given top priority. Calls for sewer back-ups, lack of heat, toilets not working, and flooding are answered immediately. After normal business hours you must call the emergency phone number (273-6085) for help. If your bathroom light is out, kitchen appliance not working, or a fuse is blown, they are not considered emergencies and must wait until the next business day. You can also leave a message on the answering machine during non-business hours, or email us at office@watervliethousing. org." *Please note that calling the emergency line for a non-emergency or calling during business hours after a warning will result in a back charge to your account.*

SENIOR MEDICAL CARDS

We provide a senior medical card for all seniors to fill out and leave in the metal sleeve next to your front door. Fill them out and keep them current. If you ever need a new one, just call the office. If you are sick and have difficulty speaking, the ambulance crew can use this to bring you to the hospital you prefer, call your personal doctor, and review your current medication. This is for your benefit. The difference in minutes could save your life.

ATTENTION WHA TENANTS

If you see garbage laying around the cites, please pick it up and throw it into a trash bin. Excessive amounts of trash will be disposed of by maintenance, but picking up one piece of trash could make all the difference!

WINTER WEATHER SAFETY

DRESS FOR THE COLD:

- wear several layers
- cover exposed body parts/limbs with clothing
- wear no-slide shoes and boots
- change out of wet clothes as soon as possible

WALKING SAFETY:

- always be cautious of where you are walking to avoid slips, trips, or falls
- do not walk outside until snow removal procedures have been completed



KNOW THE SIGNS:

Frostbite

loss of feeling in fingers, toes, ears, or nose
white or pale fingers, toes, ears, or nose

Hypothermia

- uncontrollable shivering
 - memory loss
 - disorientation
 - incoherence
 - slurred speech
 - exhaustion



HOLIDAY HEALTH TIPS

Before winter, make sure your car is ready for the season with a tune-up, adequate tires, a charged battery, and antifreeze.

• Keep emergency gear in your car

DRIVER SAFETY

- Avoid driving in bad weather. If you must, always drive slowly and with caution.
- Never sit in a parked car with the engine running unless a window is open, and never warm up your car while parked in a garage.





Census data is used to allocate funds in a number of areas including grants for school districts, public transportation, road rehabilitation and construction, programs for the elderly and youth. The majority of these programs have positively impacted Watervliet and the goal is to continue that government support. By April 1, 2020, every home will receive an invitation to participate in the census. You will have three options for responding: by mail, by phone and online! The 2020 census marks the first time you'll have the option to respond online- you can even respond from your cell phone. Please make a firm commitment to complete your census! Please remember that all personal information provide is strictly confidential.
