Call in any work orders before the inspection at 273-4717. Poor housekeeping, missing fire detectors, and any damage beyond ordinary wear and tear are grounds for a failed inspection.

JOSLIN LAUNDRY ROOM

Attention Joslin tenants: please do not forget your laundry in the washing machines or dryers for an extended period of time. This causes an inconvenience to other tenants and creates a dirty environment for all. DO NOT OVERLOAD THE MACHINES. We have had an increased number of costly damages caused to the washers and dryers being overloaded. The room is monitored by surveillance cameras. If it is found that you overload the machines, you will be charged to fix them. Also, don't forget that the hours that you can access the laundry room are from 8am-8pm.

NYSPHADA SCHOLARSHIP 2020

Are you graduating in June? The NYSPHADA Scholarship Application Packet for 2020 can be found on their website at <u>www.nysphada.org</u> under the Scholarship tab. The application is open to all graduating High School Seniors who are residents of Housing Authority properties or Section 8 programs. There are strict requirements within the application and ALL deadlines must be met. There will be no exceptions made. *The Watervliet Housing Authority will pay the \$50 application fee on your behalf.* Only the first two completed applications will be submitted. Contact our office if you are interested in this scholarship. All applications **must be submitted by February 24th, 2020!**

MOUSE PROBLEMS

LAST DAY TO PAY RENT

You MUST report all income changes! Failure to provide timely and accurate information regarding new jobs, pay rate increases, and increased hours may result in charges owed to the WHA and possible eviction.

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

CDTA STAR PROGRAM: STAR is Special Transit Available by Request; a Para-transit service offering transportation alternatives to people whom at certain times cannot use, or have substantial limits using, the CDTA fixedroute bus system because of a disability or impairment. CDTA provides eligibility for complementary para-transit service to individuals who live outside of the STAR service area but they can only receive STAR service for travel within the service area. It is complementary to CDTA's fixed route bus system. It operates within 3/4 of a mile of a CDTA's fixed route bus system on the same days and times that CDTA's fixed route bus system operates. For example, if a CDTA bus operates from 6AM - 7PM, Monday- Friday along a specific route, then STAR is available from 6AM - 7PM, Monday- Friday within 3/4 of a mile on either side of that route. It is a shared ride, providing origin to destination rides for work, appointments, shopping, and social activities. Remembering that STAR is a complimentary service, trips requests with origins and/or destinations beyond these route corridor boundaries and/or beyond the service times of the corresponding fixed route will not be accepted. <u>A+ MEDITRANS CURB-TO-CURB SERVICE</u>: This program offers several services to clients. One of their transportations includes curb-to-curb service. It provides transportation to individuals, with full mobility, that do not require assistance from their homes to our vehicles. Clients may enter and exit the vehicle independently while drivers stand near in the event that assistance is required. Clients with full mobility may include individuals with varying disabilities that are not always physically apparent. Clients may schedule appointments in advance or call for same day service. SHRED 518 MEDICAB: Shred 518 is a medical taxi transportation service. Their services include transportation to doctor, dentist, podiatrist, substance abuse, mental health, eye doctor, physical therapy, and/or dialysis appointments. They provide transportation to patients who are elderly, have chronic illnesses, disabilities, require basic travel needs (grocery shopping or essential outpatient care). 
