




CARD PAYMENTS NOW ACCEPTED

The WHA Office is now accepting rent payments by credit or debit card! You can either enter your information on your own through a link on our website, or you can bring your card into the office. *Please be advised that there is a fee attached to these payments added right on to the payment.* Fees vary based on the amount paid but are a minimum of \$3. This system is separate from our portal and these payments will never be automatically withdrawn- you will have to pay them manually each time. This is an additional payment method we are accepting for the convenience of our tenants, so we will continue to accept money orders and checks as usual.

WHAT DO I DO IF MY FRIDGE LOSES POWER?

Food in your fridge will stay cold for about four hours if the doors remain closed, and a freezer will generally keep its temperature for 48 hours. According to the FDA, food that has remained at or below 40 degrees is safe to eat or refreeze. It might not be a bad idea to keep a cooler on hand in the event that your fridge is out for an extended period of time. We always work as fast as we can to get fridges back up and running, but sometimes we have to rely on an outside company and timelines are out of our control.

VEHICLE REGISTRATION

Please make sure any vehicles that are on the property are registered with the WHA Office. If we have to plow after it snows and your vehicle can't be identified, you will be towed at your expense. If you have someone that frequently visits your apartment (ex: Home Health Aide, family member) it might be a good idea to keep their information on file too so we know who to contact if their vehicle needs to be moved.



PET POLICY REMINDERS

A reminder to all pet owners in the WHA, please make sure all shot and licensing records are up to date. Failure to keep this information is a violation of the Pet Policy and could result in the receipt of a 30 Day Vacate.



Additionally, please make sure to clean up after your pet. Failure to dispose of pet waste properly will result in a charge of \$50 applied to your account. Your neighbors should not have to clean up after you, please be respectful of the grounds that you call home.
