CHILDREN AT PLAY

An additional benefit is that your kids will have fewer opportunities to get into trouble because they aren't spending too much unsupervised time with other children.

AIR CONDITIONERS

Please remember, you must have a 2x4 piece of wood under your air conditioner to protect the storm windows. The unit cannot be placed on the storm window or it will damage the frame. If you need the 2x4's, contact the WHA office. Please save the 2x4's to reuse the following year.

RENT PAYMENTS AND PAPERWORK

Please be sure that you sign and write your apartment number on ALL checks and money orders! Additionally, you can drop your check or money orders in **EITHER** of the two boxes outside of our temporary office location. To use the larger mail box, just pull down on the handle, place your paperwork or rent payment in, and then close the bin.
