KEY FOB PRICE CHANGE

Effective immediately, the price of key fobs is being raised to \$10.00 from \$8.00. Key fobs are the small gray key card that is used to enter to the Joslin and VRV laundry rooms, and the building at Hanratta. If you lose your key fob or request an additional key fob, a charge of \$10 will be applied to your account.

LATE FEES

Late fees are billed after the fifth business day of the month. The amount of your late fee is 5% of your Total Tenant Payment amount. This amount varies slightly from your regular rental amount, as it is what your rent would be without the utility allowance that is calculated into your established rental amount. VRV INSPECTIONS

Van Rensselaer Village inspections will be held from March 7th through March 10th beginning at 10 AM. We need to access all of your windows. Please make sure ALL items are removed from the window area. Remove all items off the top of your stove and off the burners. You do not need to be home for the inspection. Please promptly notify the WHA if anyone in your family has any COVID-19 symptoms or if anyone has tested positive. All staff entering your apartment will be wearing masks and will maintain proper social distancing practices. The schedule is as follows:

WORK ORDER CHARGES

PET POLICY

Don't forget that **ALL** pets must be registered with the WHA! Pets must be spayed or neutered, up-to-date on their shots (*rabies and distemper*) and dogs are required to be registered with the City of Water-vliet. You can register your dog at the Clerk's Office at City Hall (*2 Fifteenth Street*).

All paperwork with updated shot records and license's must be reported to the WHA Office. Failure to keep your pets vaccinations current and/or failure to provide appropriate documentation could result in a 30 day notice to vacate. DAYLIGHT SAVINGS

Don't forget daylight savings begins on Sunday, March 12th. Clocks will go forward one hour at 2:00AM!

HEAP

The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) helps low-income individuals pay the cost of heating their homes. If you are eligible, you may receive one regular HEAP benefit per program year and could also be eligible for emergency HEAP benefits if you are in danger of running out of fuel or having your utility service shut off. You can apply for a Regular HEAP Benefit online at *mybenefits.ny.gov*.

CLOSE YOUR WINDOWS

If windows are left open- even a crack- your radiators may freeze and then burst causing significant damage inside your apartment and possible personal loss. You will be charged for all repairs if you are deemed responsible.

MARY'S CORNER

Mary's Corner provides a service to adults caring for children aged newborn to 3 years who live in the cities of Cohoes and Watervliet. On a monthly basis, families are eligible to receive items at no cost. These items include but are not limited to: clothing, diapers and formula. Please note that proof of residency is required. LICENSE PLATES

It is vital that the WHA has your updated car information. In the event we need to move cars to plow, if we attempt to contact you but do not have your updated vechicle information on file, we will have to tow your car.
